



Declaration of Intent of the Office of the Civil Service Commission

Subject: No-gift policy for the fiscal year B.E. 2567 (2024)

The Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), as the central human resource management agency of the civil service under the merit system, places importance on any efforts to suppress corruption and misconduct. The OCSC aims to foster the civil service values and instill such values in its civil servants and officials so that they put honesty, integrity, and impartiality at the heart of their work and avoid seeking any benefits that will result in corruption and misconduct, whether now or in the future.

Considering that the pursuit of this goal is of great significance, the Secretary-General, as the head of the organization, and the OCSC's civil servants and officials, wish to jointly make this declaration of intent. The OCSC is an organization where all civil service officials do not receive any gifts, while, before or after performing their duties. The no-gift policy issued by the organization will be strictly adhered to.
